Figure 01. Age Standardized Hospitalization Rate due to Accidental Falls, All Ages, EOHU & Ontario, 2013-2022

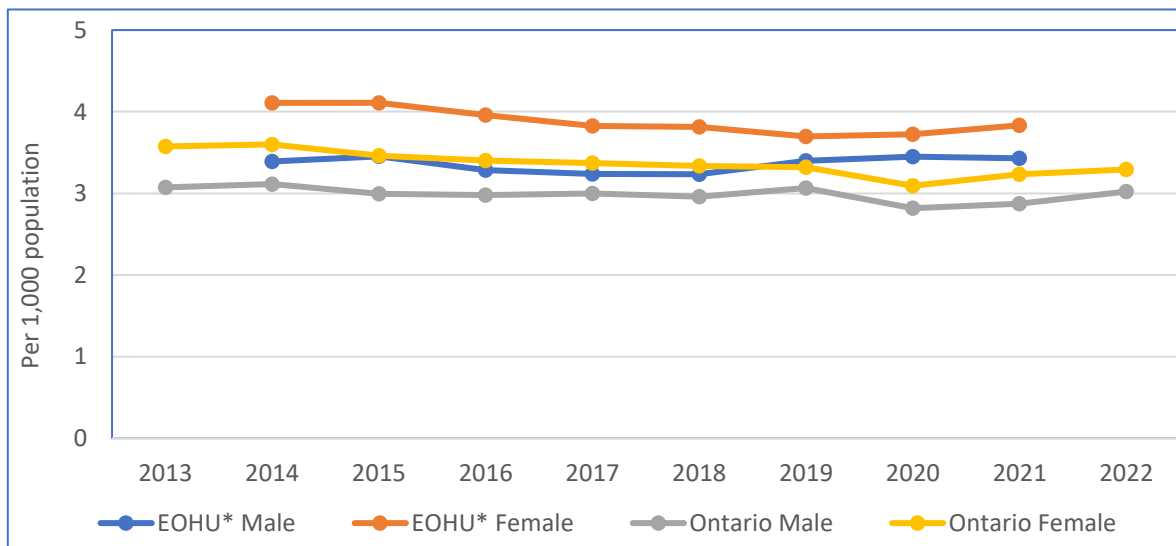
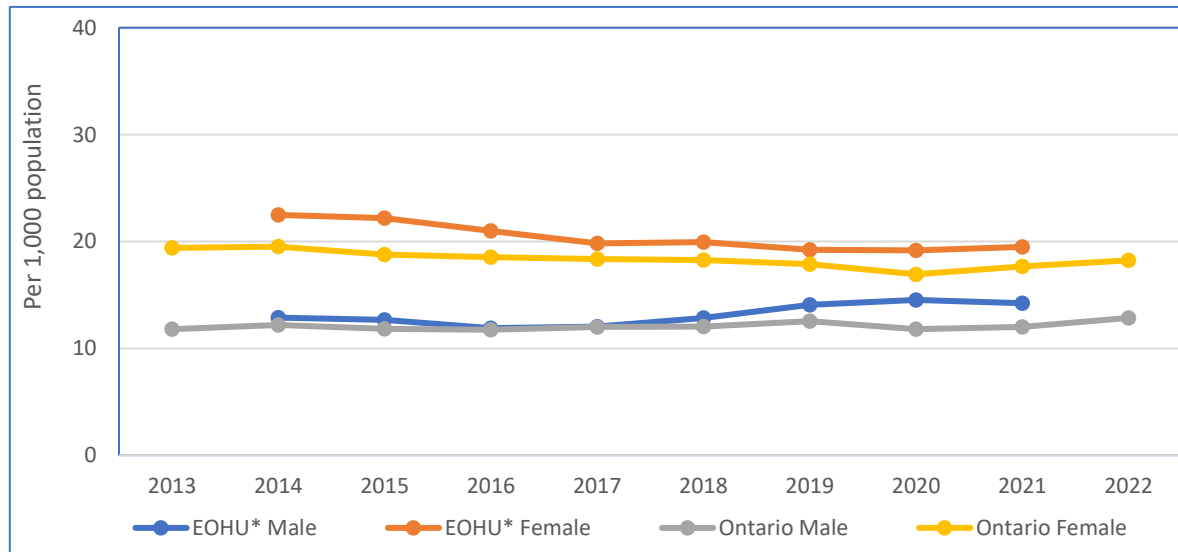

Figure 02. Age Specific Hospitalization Rate due to Accidental Falls, 65 Years & up, EOHU & Ontario, 2013-2022

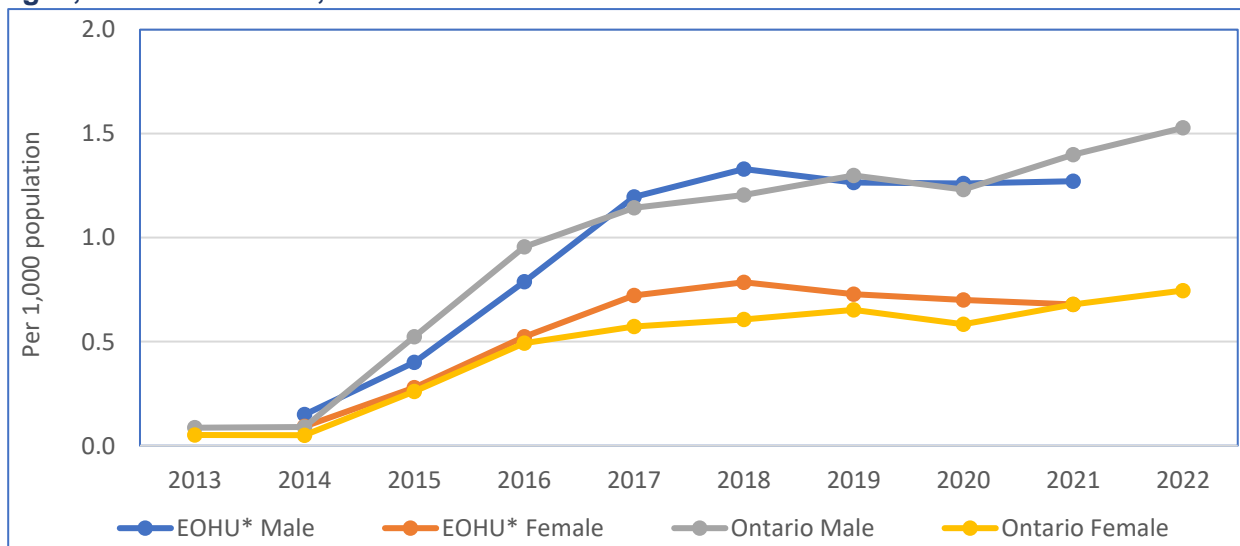

Figure 03. Age Standardized Hospitalization Rate due to Accidental Suffocation, All Ages, EOHU & Ontario, 2013-2022

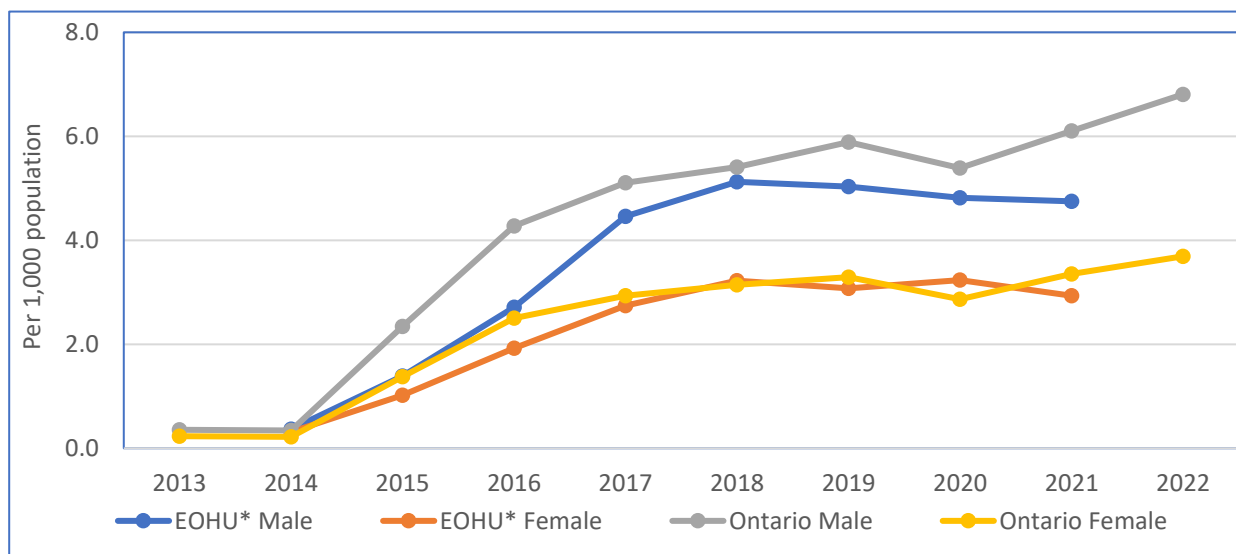

Figure 05. Age Standardized Hospitalization Rate due to MVA, All Ages, EOHU & Ontario, 2013-2022

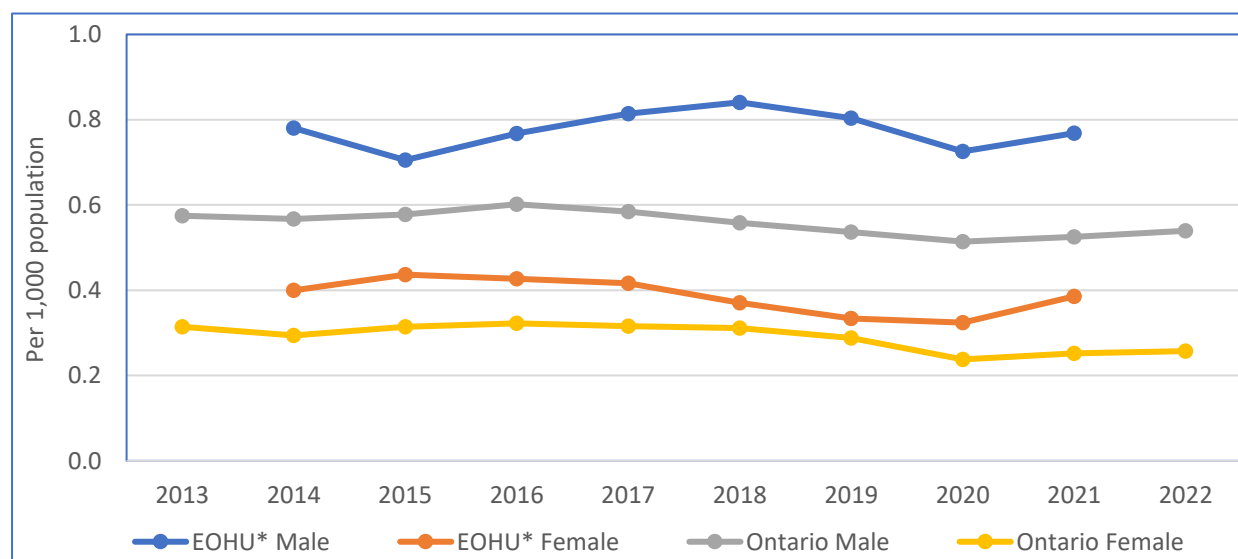
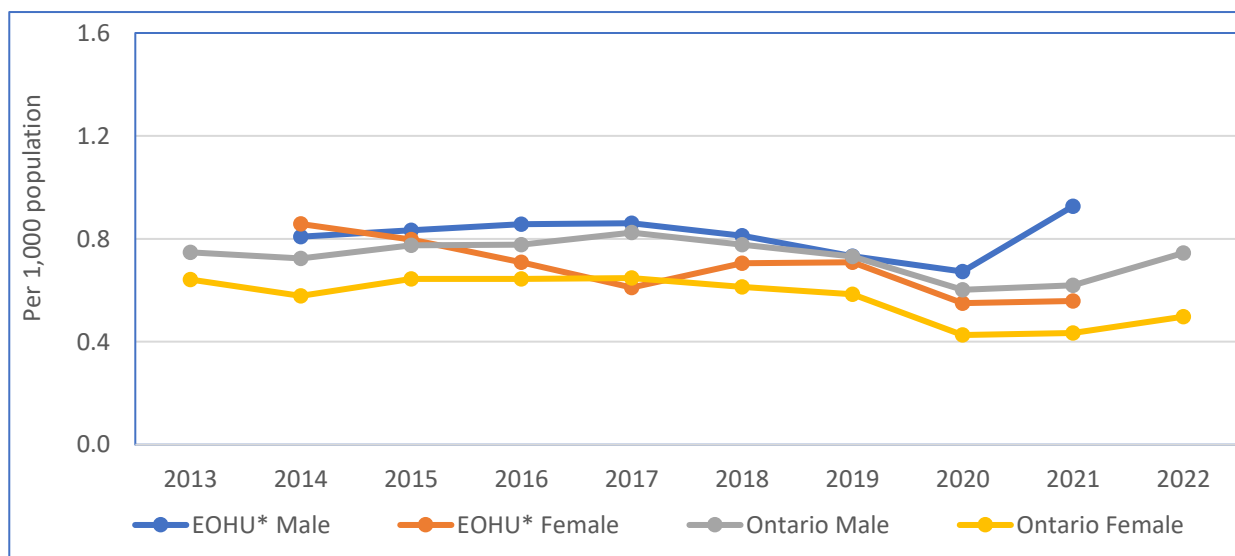
